

Winter work programme 2009

Greens

- Aerate with pencil tines and slit tines every 2-3 weeks, alternate between the two.
- Spray seaweed and iron every 2-3weeks.
- Spray fungicide when needed.
- Cut when needed (hand cut).
- Keep free from leaves.
- Spray for worms when needed.
- Lift low drain lines in 15th green (front left and back right).
- Verti drain using 12mm tine, to a depth of 250mm (November).
- Pin positions to be changed regularly.

Tees

- Keep clear of leaves.
- Cut when needed.
- Apply lawn sand.
- Verti-drain (November)
- Solid tine monthly with drum spiker.
- Spray for worms when needed.
- Turf worn area on 11th tee bank.
- Replace sleeper on 12th tee.
- Keep divoted.
- Yardage stones on tees to be kept strimmed.

Collars and aprons

- Spray for worms and leather jackets (19th November).
- Lift low areas around 4th green, caused by previous irrigation work .Level off and re-turf.
- Slit tine and solid tine regularly (help in thatch reduction).
- Spray with iron. (help protect against disease).

Fairways

- Keep clear from leaves.
- Spray for worms and leather jackets (contractor coming in 19th November).
- Cut when needed.

Green banks

- Keep clear from leaves.
- Cut when needed.
- Spray for worms and leather jackets (19th November).

Rough

- Cut when needed.
- Certain areas to be sprayed for worms (19th November).
- Keep clear from leaves.

Semi-rough

- Keep clear from leaves
- Spray for worms (19th November).

Tee banks

- Keep clear from leaves.
- Cut when needed.
- Some areas to be sprayed for worms and leather jackets.

Bunkers and bunker banks.

- Worn bunker banks to be fed 9-7-7 fertiliser.
- Sand to be pushed up bunker faces.
- To be kept strimmed and fly mowed.
- To be kept weeded.

Ditches

- Clear leaves from ditches when all leaves have fallen.
- Streams to be kept clear of debris and any blockages.

Paths

- To be kept clear of weeds.
- To be kept clear of leaves.
- Put wooden edging on path behind 3rd green.
- Top up path 7th tee down to fairway.

Trees

- Cut back branches near practise area l.h.s 18th fairway
- Remove dead willow l.h.s 4th fairway
- Remove dead tree r.h.s 5th fairway
- Clear up branches and debris from trees.
- Piles of cut wood to be burnt up (behind 10th green l.h.s 16th fairway etc).
- Lift low branches on young trees l.h.s 14th.

Metro golf

- Change holes weekly
- Cut greens weekly
- Cut range when needed

Club house area

- Keep clear of leaves.
- Front lawns to be cut when needed

Bad weather work

- New shelves to be erected in sheds (help storage and organisation)
- Tool storage container to be re-organised.
- All machines to be jet washed.
- Shed lights to be fixed.
- Areas around sheds to be cleared and tidied.

Machines

- Most machines to be serviced oil change, air filter change etc.
- Any blades, bearings etc to be changed.

Due to the low staff levels priority will be given to leaf clearance,
maintenance and presentation.**
